



# **IMOCA Code of Conduct**

As a member of the IMOCA Class, I commit to comply with the following principles, both at sea and on land.

## Exemplarity and promotion of the values of our sport

#### <u>During the racing period, I commit to:</u>

 adopt exemplary behaviours and compete in strict compliance with the rules established by the IMOCA Class and national and international sporting authorities.

#### In general, I commit to:

- act responsibly and promote the positive values of our sport,
- act to minimise the impact of my activity on the environment,
- refrain from behaviours and/or actions that could discredit or tarnish the reputation of the IMOCA Class, its members, leaders, employees, and service providers. As such, I will exercise prudent and measured communication of all media platforms including digital or social media.

#### Respect for physical and psychological integrity

## I commit to:

- not encourage or engage in violent behaviour, nor commit any form of physical, psychological, and/or sexual abuse or harassment,
- not encourage or engage in discriminatory behaviour of any kind, based on origin, gender, age, sexual orientation, political, philosophical, or religious beliefs,
- adopt respectful behaviour and create an inclusive environment respecting everyone,
- treat everyone with fairness, dignity, and consideration,
- if necessary, report any situation of violence, abuse, or harassment of which I am aware, to ensure the safety and well-being of all within our environment.

### Fair play within and between teams

I commit to adopting fair play behaviour within my team and between teams of the IMOCA Class.

# Solidarity at sea and on land

Solidarity being a fundamental value at sea, I am also committed to respecting this value on land in order to provide assistance to any team in difficulty when the safety of property and people is at stake.





By signing this charter, I commit to respecting its provisions, and I am fully aware that any breach of this code of conduct may constitute a serious matter as referred to in Article B-III of the IMOCA internal regulations and may be referred to the IMOCA Class Executive Committee.
